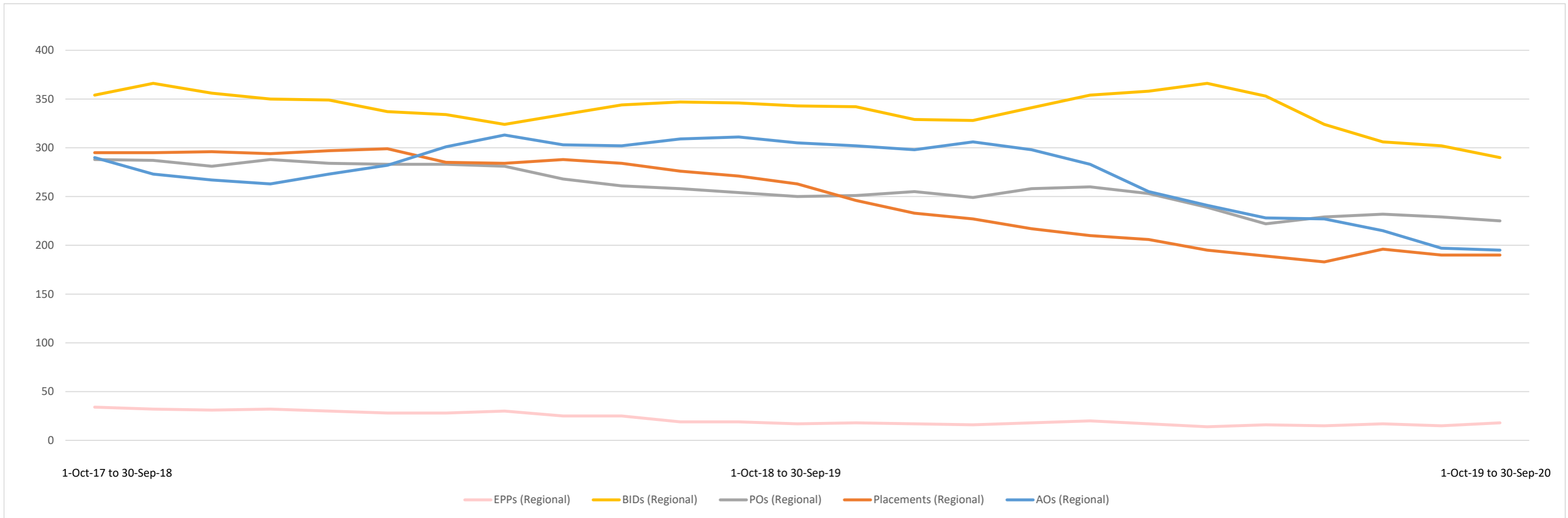

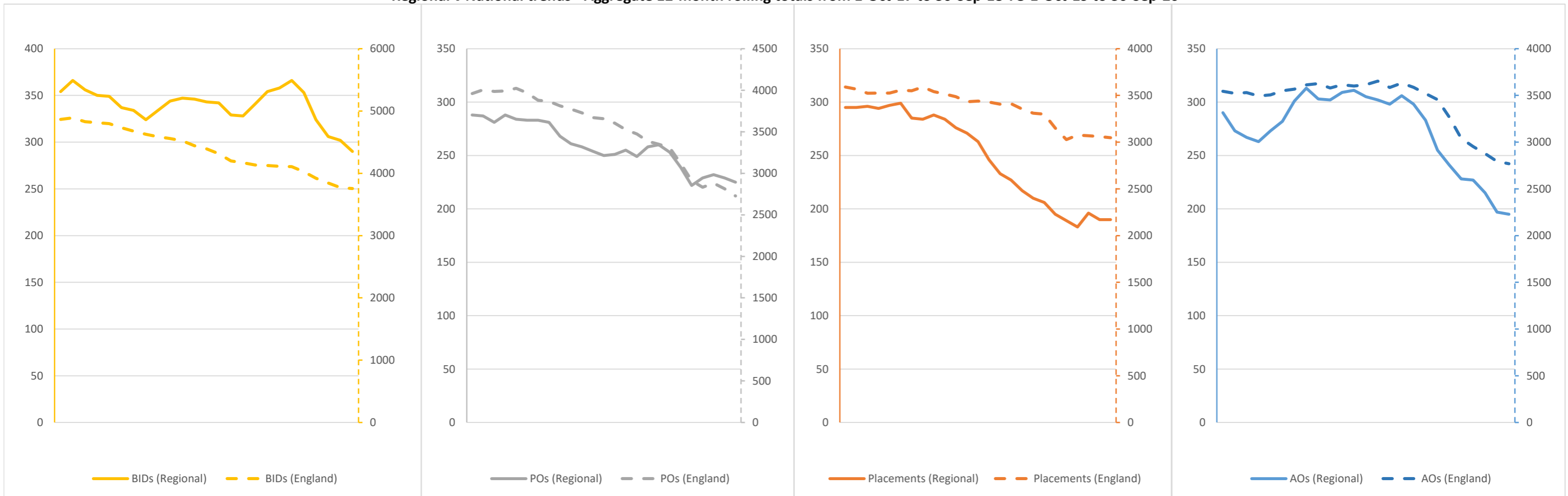

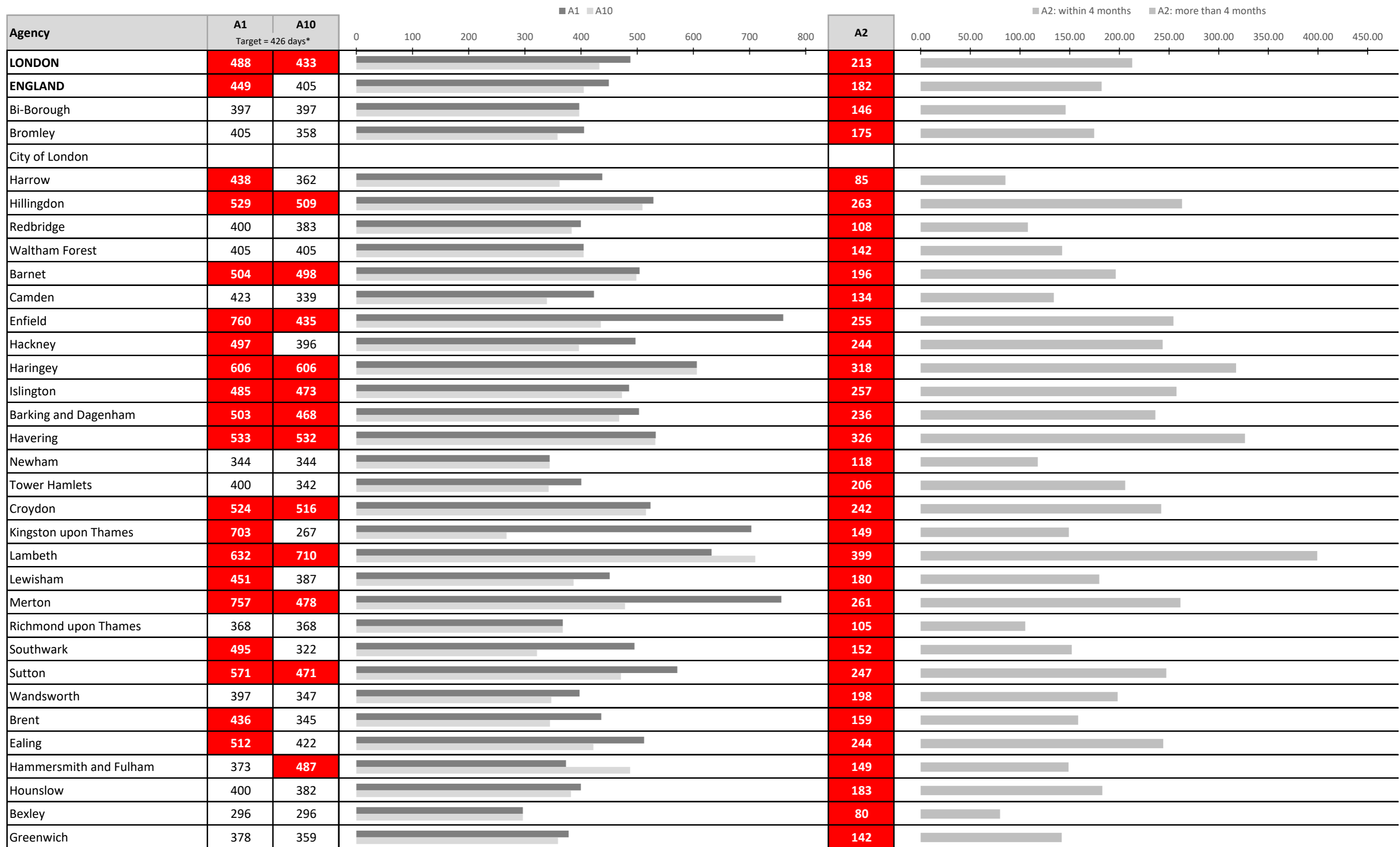

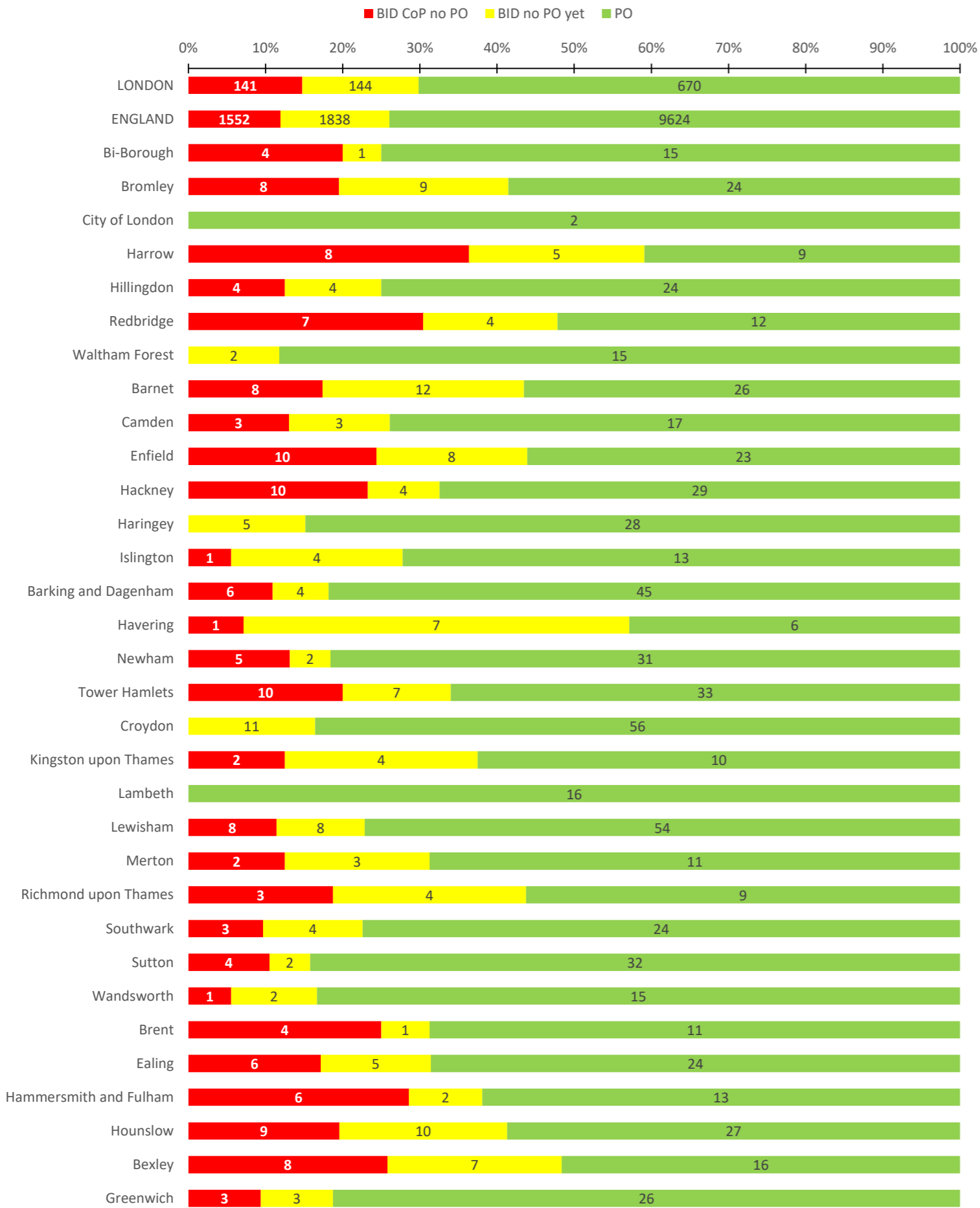

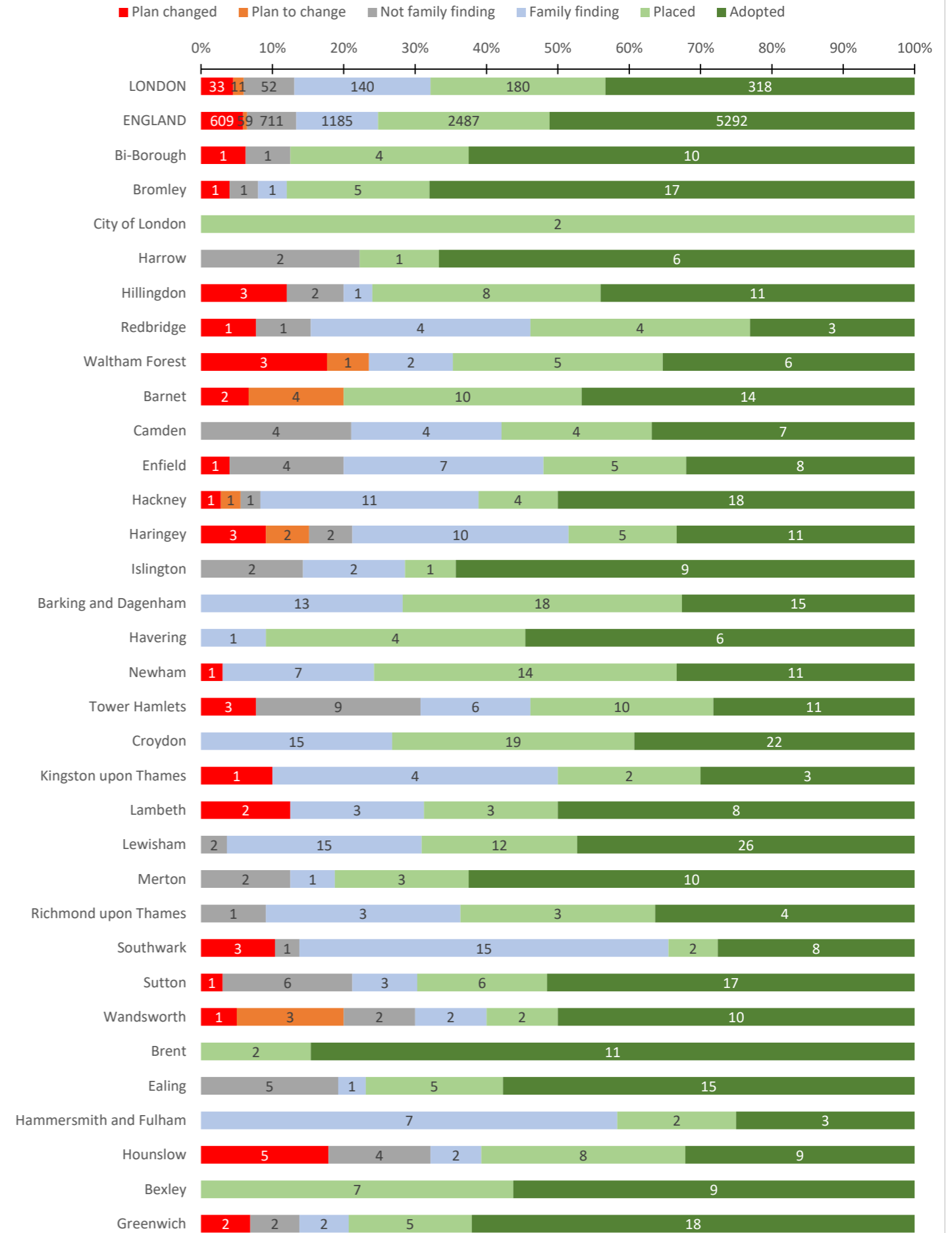

Outcomes of BIDs granted in the last three years (numbers & proportions)

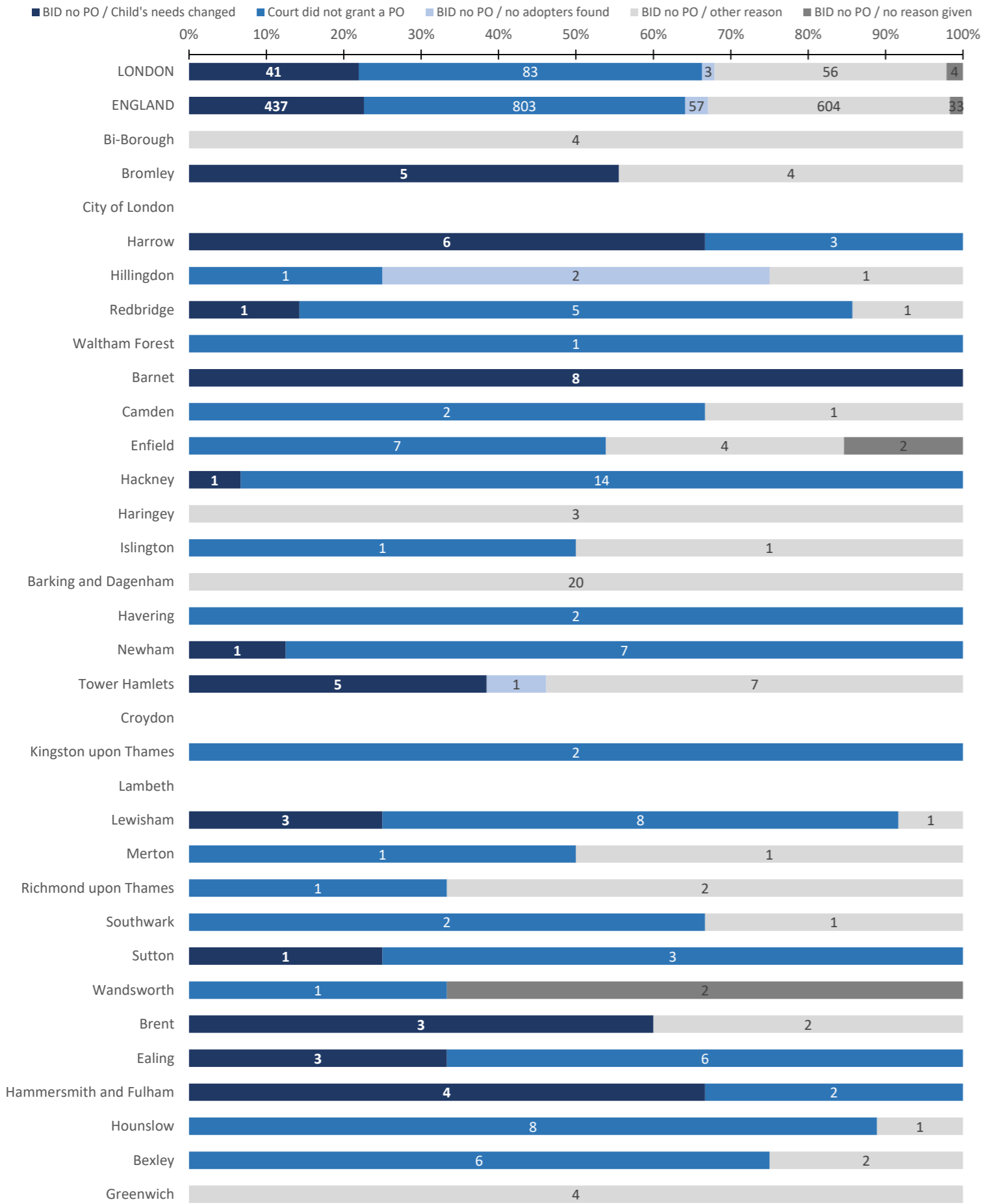


Outcomes of POs granted in the last three years (numbers & proportions)

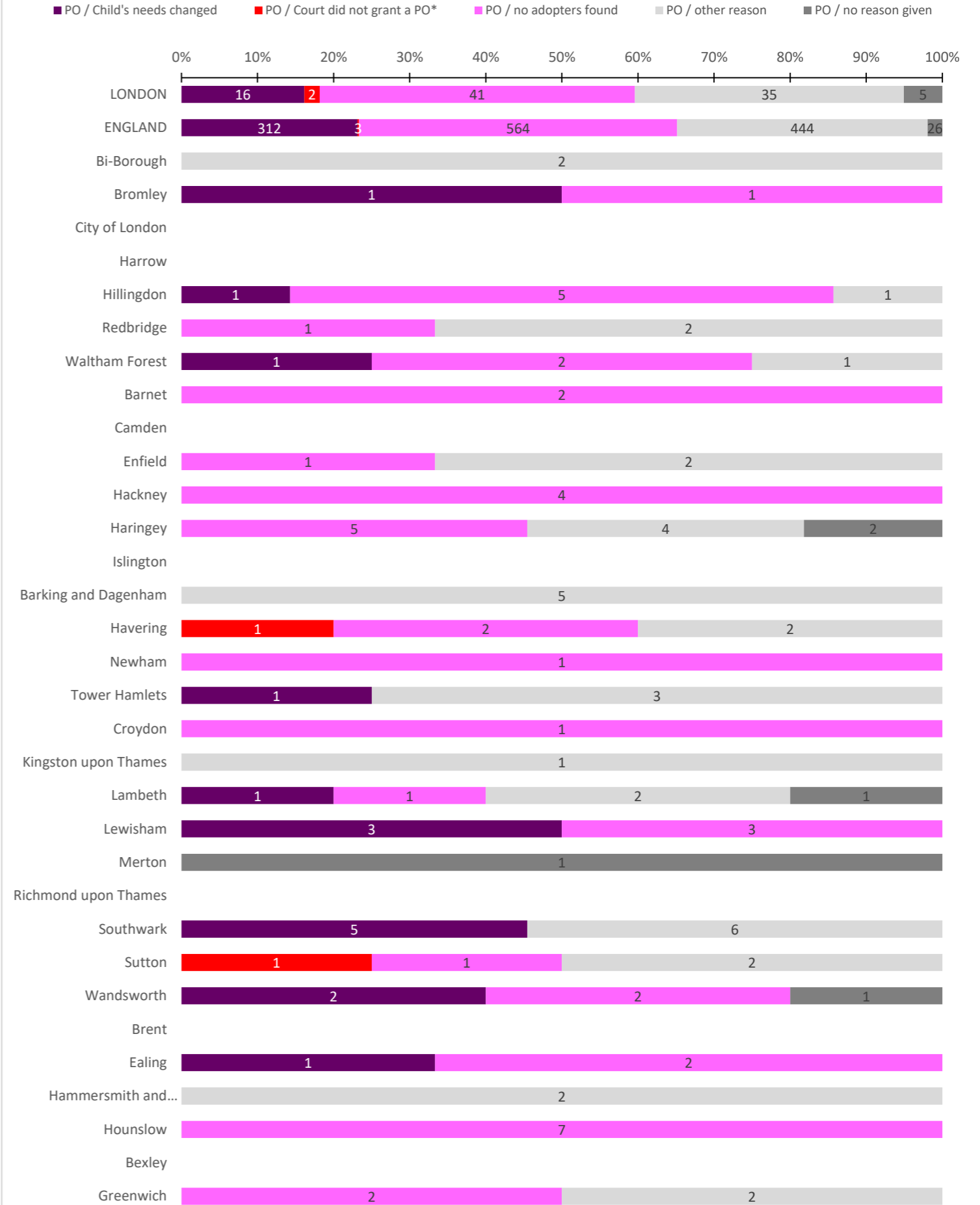


ASGLB Regional Dashboard - London 2020/21 Q2 - Recorded reasons for changes of plans made in the 3 years to 30 September 2020

Reasons for changes in plan in the last three years (BID no PO, numbers & proportions)



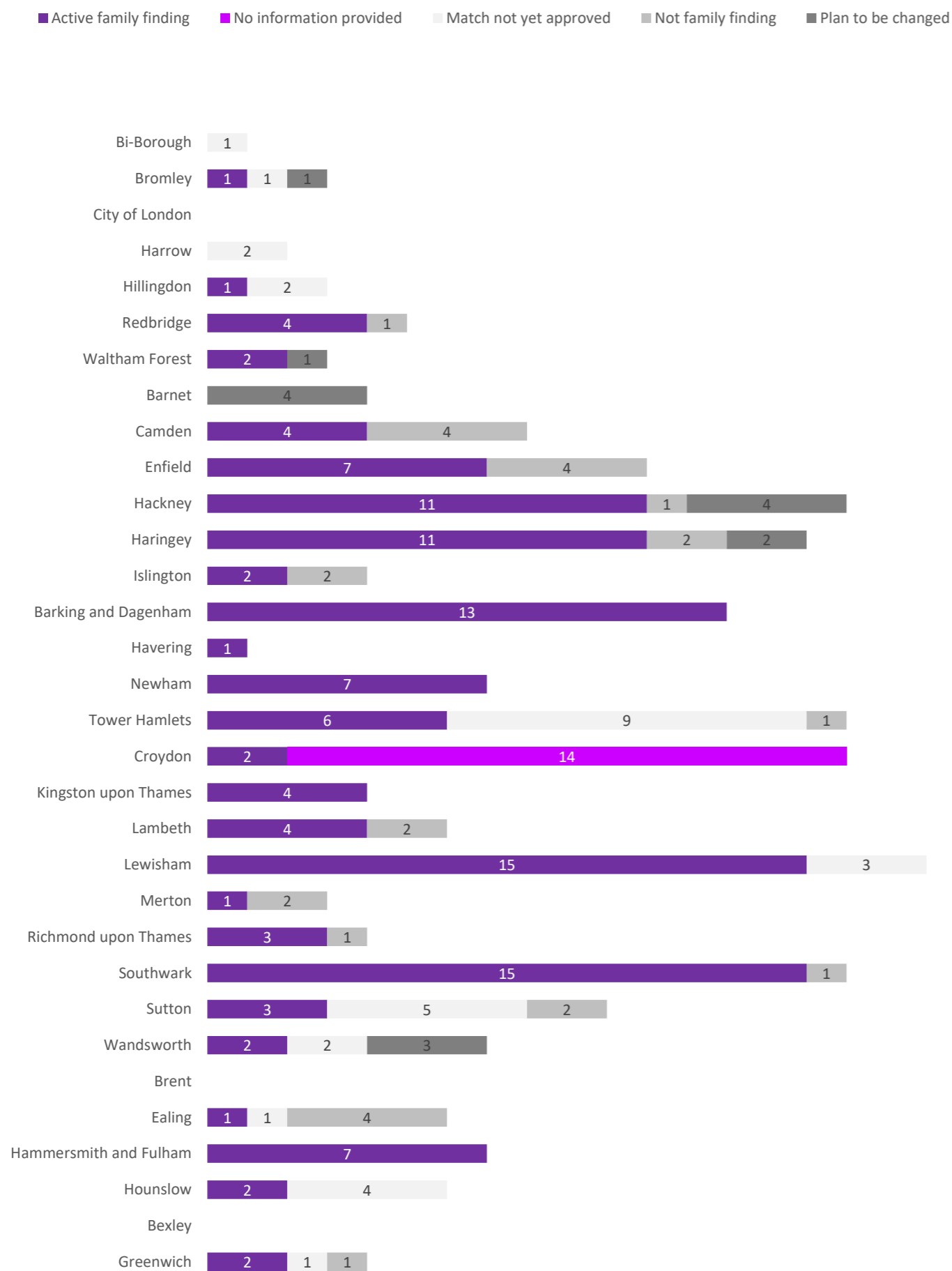
Reasons for change in plan in the last three years where PO was granted (numbers & proportions)



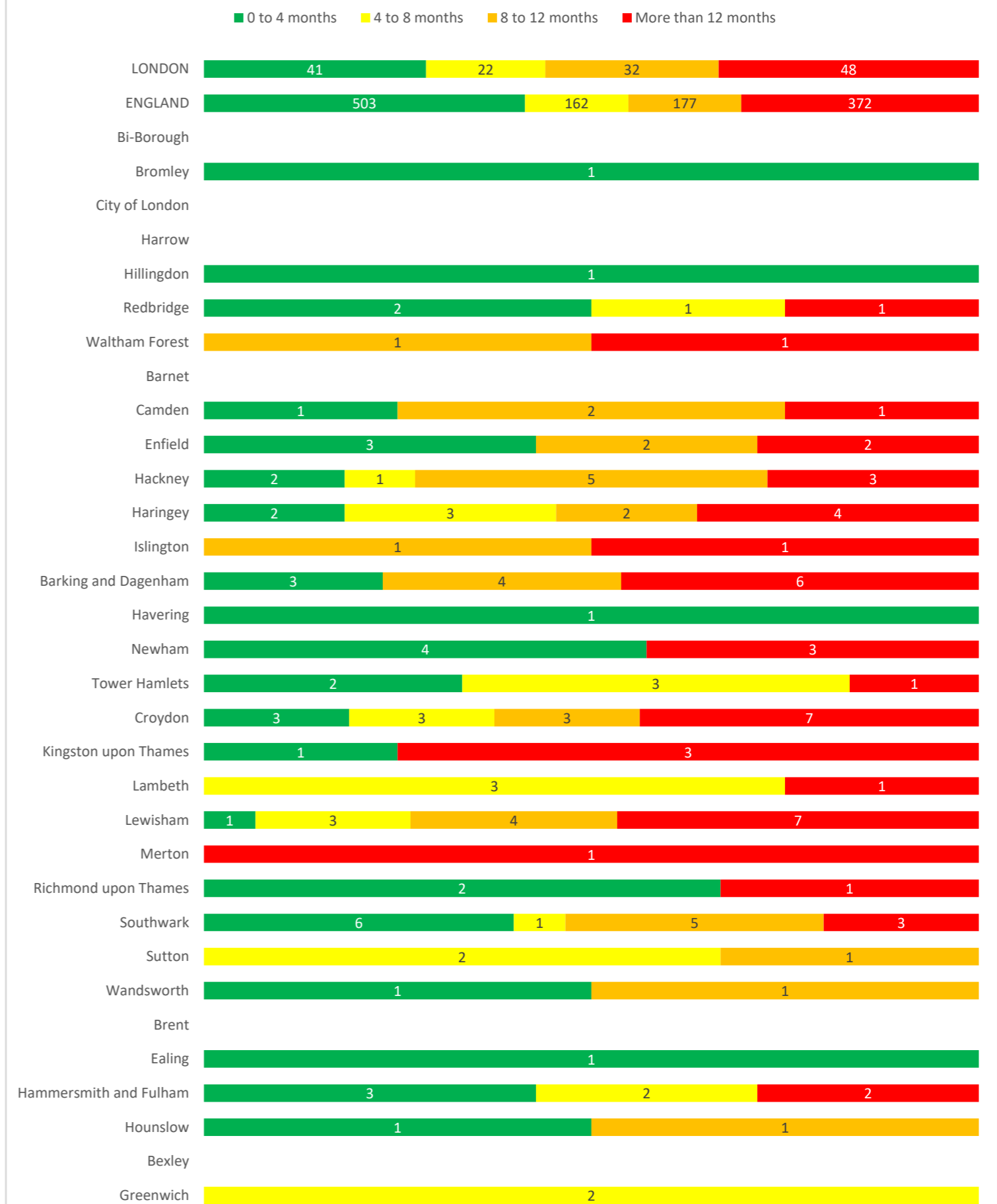

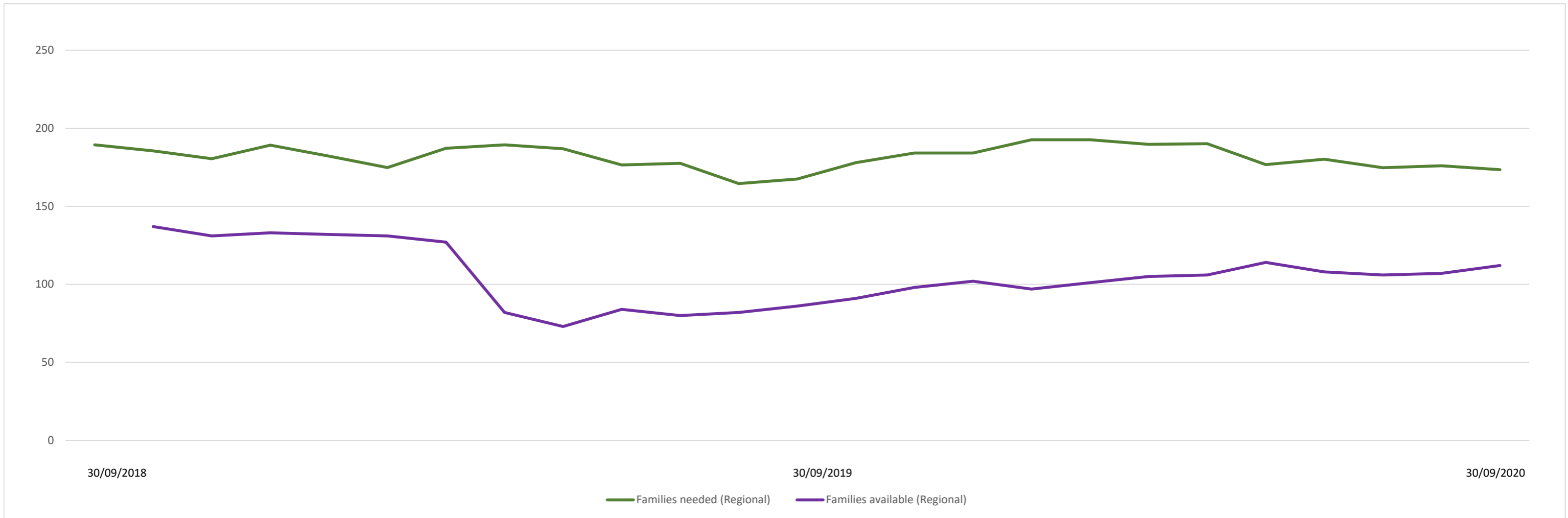
Number of children waiting with a PO and family finding not stopped*, by ethnicity and time since PO granted

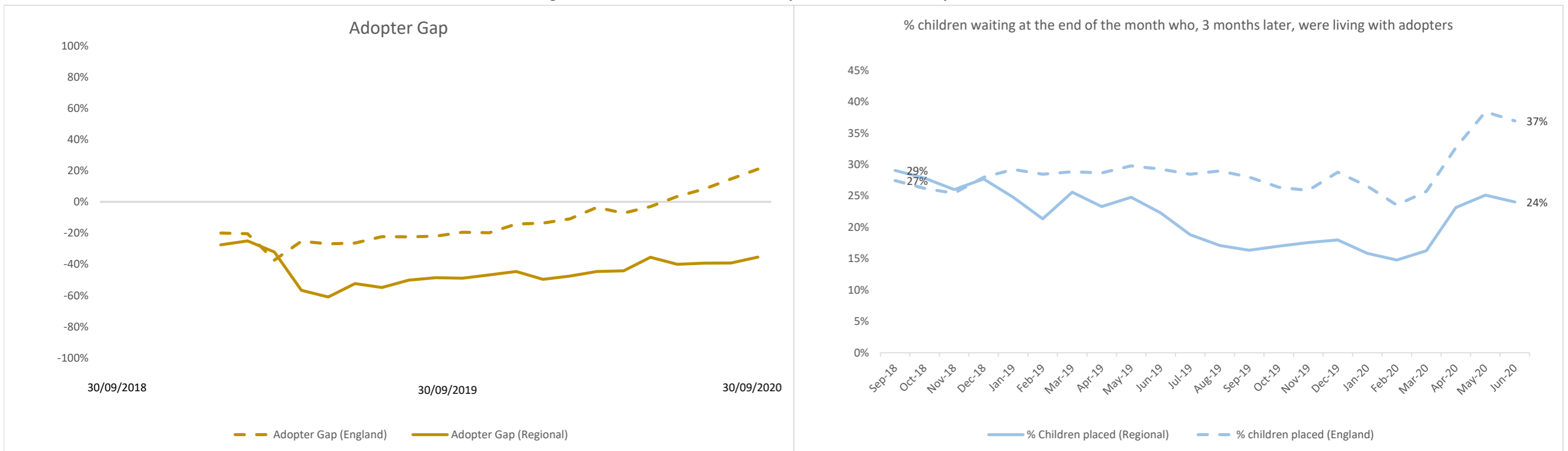

i.e. 27% of the children waiting in England on 30 September 2018 had been placed for adoption by 31 December 2018

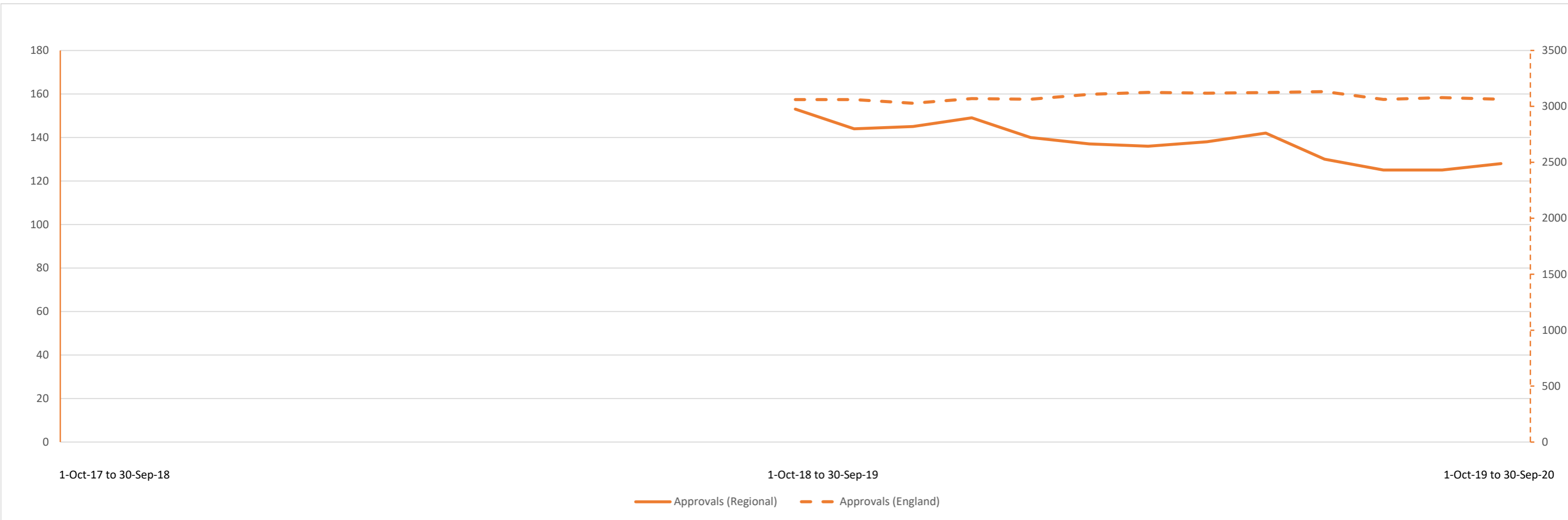

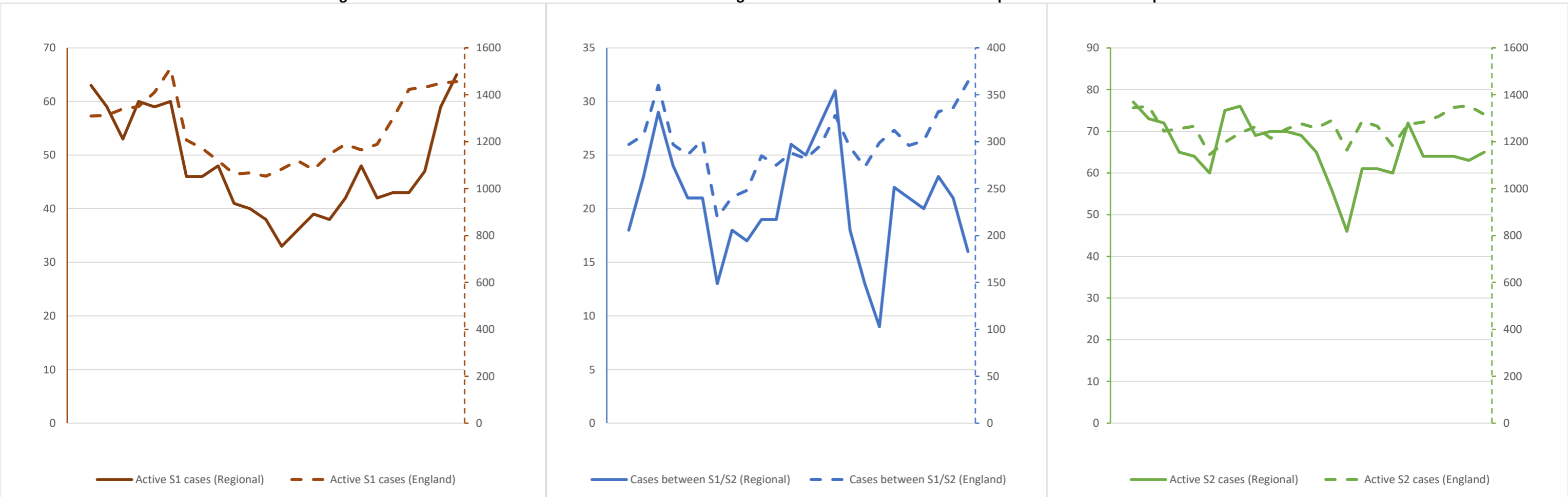

Regional v National trends for active assessments in each stage at the end of the month from 30 September 2018 to 30 September 2020

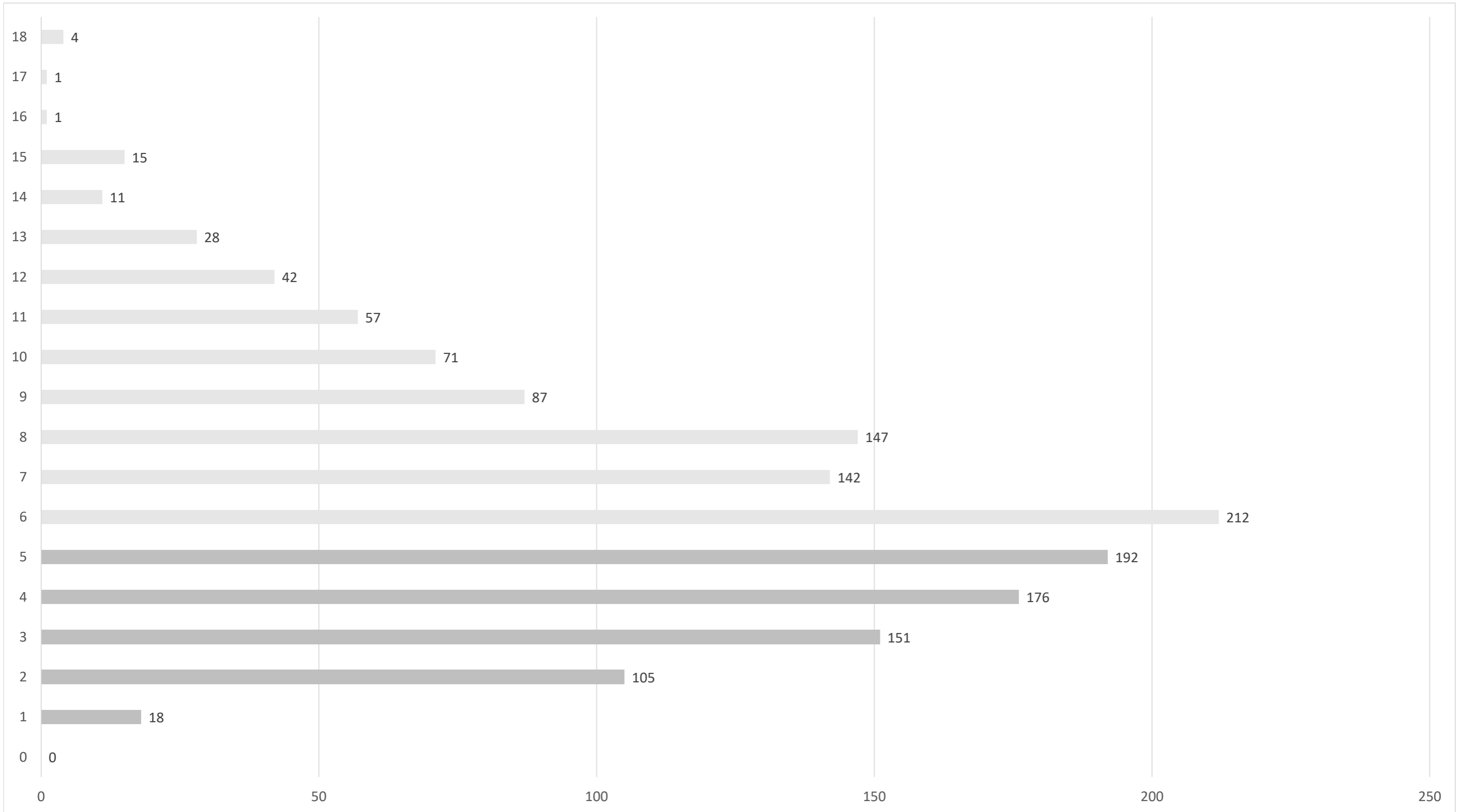

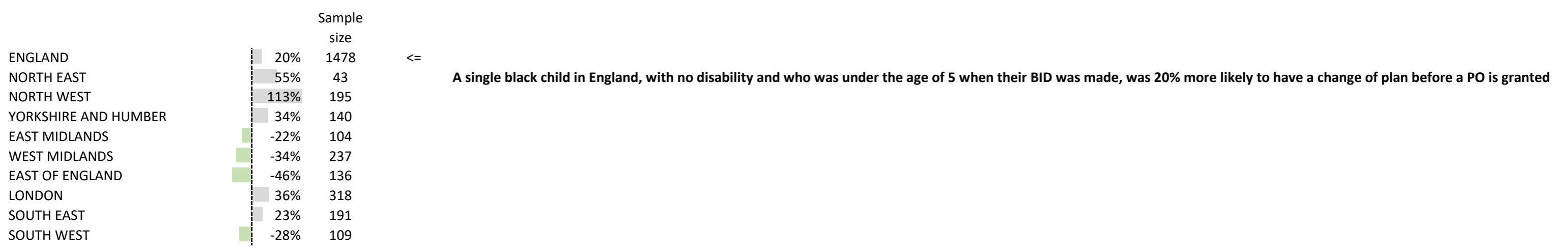

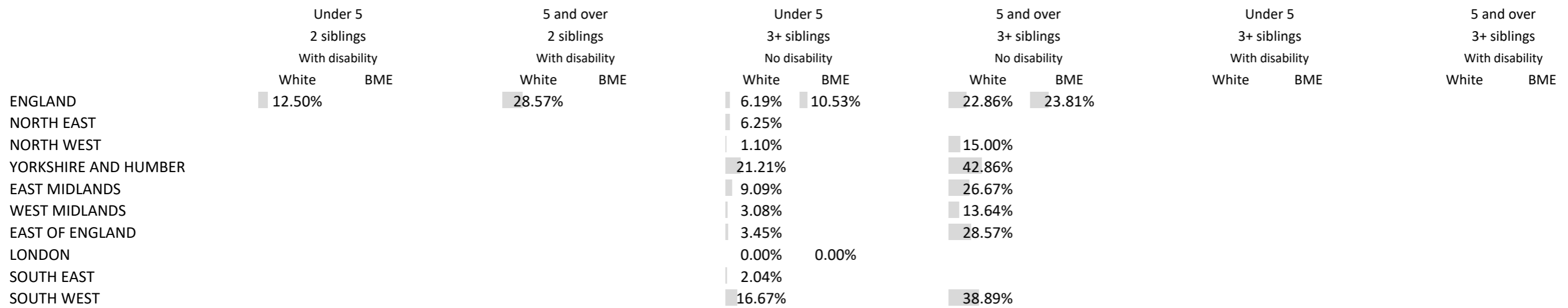

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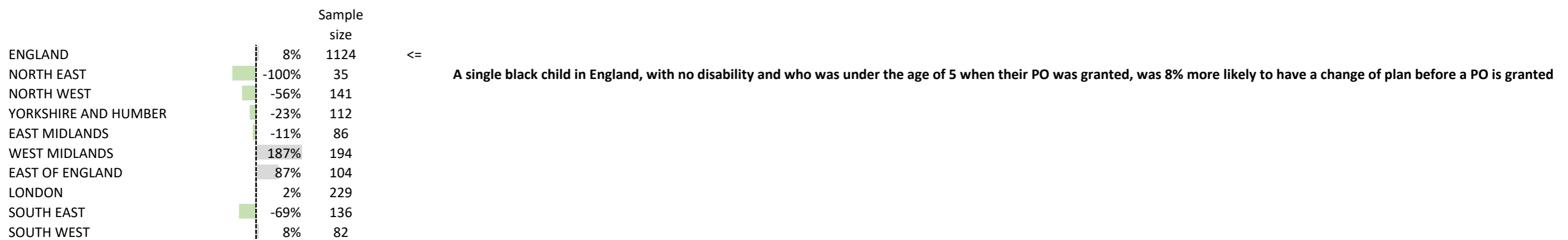
