




ASGLB Regional Dashboard - London 2020/21 Q2 - Outcomes from BIDs made and POs granted in the 3 years to 30 September 2020





ASGLB Regional Dashboard - London 2020/21 Q2 - Recorded reasons for changes of plans made in the 3 years to 30 September 2020










ASGLB Regional Dashboard - London 2020/21 Q2 - Top 5 most represented characteristics among children waiting with a PO, family finding not stopped*
