Our offer:

The Intervention First Team offer a free 12 session programme to children in the Harlesden cluster. The programme provides intensive support for children in school or at home. We will work closely with you to develop a bespoke intervention plan for each child referred to the service.

This plan may include:

- Home and school observation and feedback
- Behavioural support
- Parental support sessions
- Therapeutic interventions to improve psychological wellbeing
- Support for teachers and SENDCO
- Whole school training

All interventions will be underpinned by the SCERTS model and EYFS curriculum

Who is it for:

- Harlesden Primary Schools
- Children from reception+ aged 4-7 years
- Children with SEMH needs who are struggling to manage in the classroom
- Children who do not currently have an EHCP
